## Park Grizzly Bear Adopts *her* Mother's Cub

The summer of 2011 will stand out in Grand Teton National Park's wildlife legacy. In May, two well-known grizzly bears, dubbed 399 and 610 by scientists, emerged from their dens with new cubs: 399 with three, 610 with two. Although just two of about fifty or more grizzlies in the ecosystem nurturing new cubs, these bears are anything but ordinary—they learned to live much of their lives near roadsides in full view of thrilled onlookers. With word about the cubs traveling fast, fans flocked to the park daily to witness this small but unprecedented bit of history unfold.

The bears' intrigue is heightened by the knowledge that 399 is 610's mother and that the five cubs are poignant poster children of the changing spectrum of grizzly bears in the park. In 2011, both mothers were identifiable by their quarter-sized ear tags: 399 with red, 610 with yellow. These tags, combined with overlapping home ranges and DNA analyses from samples collected during previous research captures, positively identified these bears as mother and daughter.

But the story gets better. One late July morning a grizzly bear with yellow ear tags and three cubs was observed in Willow Flats near Jackson Lake Lodge. Confused, some immediately accused biologists of switching ear tags on the two mothers. Others watched and waited, hoping for a more plausible explanation. Within days, a sighting of 399 still wearing red ear tags but now followed by only two cubs was confirmed. Putting the pieces together revealed with high certainty an extremely rare event—the adoption of a cub. And as of late October, the adopted cub

was still with 610, nixing speculation that it might go back to its birth mother.

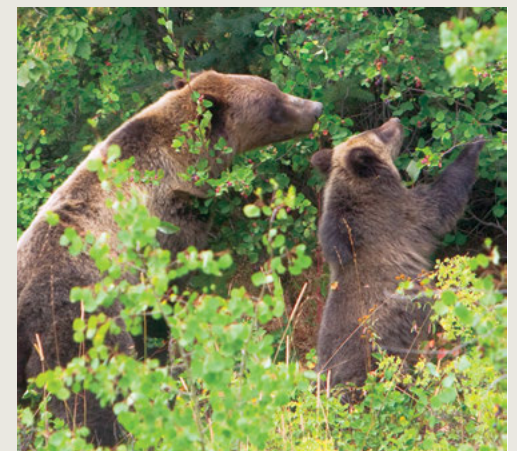
In bears, adoption is generally believed to result from traumatic events that separate family groups. In Yellowstone National Park (YNP), researchers John and Frank Craighead observed cub adoption in the 1960s when threatening encounters with other bears at garbage dumps were common. A 2007 adoption of two cubs was reported to have been preceded by an antagonistic encounter with wolves. Interestingly, just prior to this summer's adoption, park residents reported the sounds of bears fighting in an area frequented by both bear families.

This sort of altruistic parenting (behavior that benefits the recipient at the expense of the benefactor) is somewhat inconsistent with classical evolutionary theory, but various forms of it occur in at least 120 mammal and 150 bird species. One adoption hypothesis suggests an individual's behavior toward relatives influences its overall genetic fitness. This line of reasoning predicts that bears

would be more likely to adopt related young. But while documenting adoptions is difficult enough, discerning relationships among the players in the wild is usually impossible. Knowing the relationships in these cases—610's adoption of her mother's cub and the 2007 YNP adoption where relatedness was verified through DNA—substantiates this inclusive fitness hypothesis and will permanently etch these records into the scientific literature, as well as into many park visitors' memories.

# Outdoor Education, Grand Teton Style

When Sydney Taylor and Joseph Vaughn applied for the NPS Academy, a new career prep program in Grand Teton, they had very different intentions.

Sydney, a business major at Savannah State University, wanted to “do something different” with his spring break. He’d never visited Wyoming and knew nothing about the National Park Service (NPS).

Joseph knew he wanted to work outside. A forestry major at Gordon College, he was eager to get out of the classroom and into the woods.

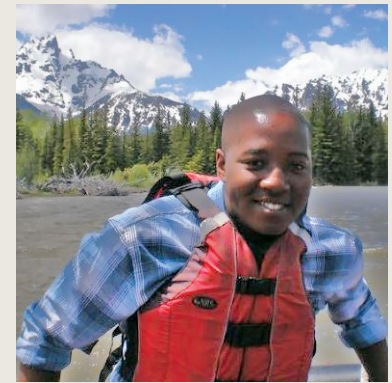
Sydney and Joseph were 2 of 29 diverse college students who were introduced to NPS careers through experiential workshops in March 2011. Students were paired with an NPS mentor and 21 received a summer internship in a national park. Of the 8 employed in Grand Teton, Joseph pursued his passion as part of the fire crew, while Sydney put his business experience to use as the professional services intern. As a fire effects monitor, Joseph determined if areas burned correctly. He assessed whether habitat was destroyed or if invasive species had moved in. He explored other departments on weekends, shadowing the EMS coordinator, driving the park ambulance, and assisting in rescues. Joseph shadowed Superintendent Mary Gibson Scott, too.

Sydney’s impression of the NPS involved wearing a flat hat as a ranger, but he was surprised when his internship focused on business and human resources. Encouraged by NPS staff, Sydney attended a youth summit in Denver and brainstormed about programs to increase youth outdoor participation. Sydney’s group proposed a temporary closure of an inner-city street in Texas to serve as a venue for outdoor activities. They received funding to launch the project. Back at college, he’s raising awareness about parks. “I was going to become a teacher, but all I can see myself doing is working for the NPS,” Sydney said. True to his dream, he is returning to Grand Teton this summer to make that vision a reality.

For Joseph, pursuing forestry is “harder now that I realize there are more options. My heart wants to continue in the Tetons and do fire. But I want to see what else there is. I like little kids, so maybe I’ll be an interpretation ranger.”

Whatever they pursue, it’s clear the academy was life-changing. “I’ve grown so much as a person because I was selected for this opportunity,” Sydney said. The program returns March 2012 to connect a new group of students to an invaluable education.

## **Craig Thomas Discovery and Visitor Center Auditorium**

154 seats, 3,600 sf. A wall of windows frames the Tetons.

A high-tech auditorium, the final phase of the visitor facility, opened in April 2011. The space was popular from day one and provides an inspiring setting for lectures, Grand Teton's new film festival, and other events related to parks and conservation.

## **Wildlife and Natural Resource Initiative**

### **WILDLIFE RESEARCH**

Studies occur year round. Wolverines are the latest species in the spotlight.

The Foundation supports species protection by providing state-of-the-art equipment that advances knowledge building in the park and beyond. Gifts strengthened studies related to wolverines, bears, wolves, pika, sage grouse, and migration.

### **BEAR BOXES**

70 boxes in 2011. 0 bears in trouble.

Bear-resistant food storage lockers are populating campsites across the park as the Foundation provides bear boxes that encourage visitors to secure food and attractants that tempt bears.

### **AIR QUALITY MONITORING STATION**

Partnership includes WY Department of Environmental Quality, NPS Air Resources Division, Teton Science Schools, and Foundation donors.

Until September 2011, air quality data for Jackson came from Yellowstone Lake and Pinedale. The station, on the Teton Science Schools' Kelly campus, collects meteorological data and provides information about visual air quality, ozone, sulfur dioxide, fine particles, and other pollutants.

### **WATER BOTTLE REFILLING STATIONS**

Located at Jenny and String Lakes, Colter Bay, Craig Thomas Discovery and Visitor Center, and Flagg Ranch.

Refillable water bottles are abundant in Grand Teton as people choose to reduce disposable plastics. Installed in 2011, eight extended spigots make refilling easy. Signage encourages visitors to reduce, reuse, and refill.

### **WHITEBARK PINE RESTORATION**

Site identification and propagation are underway.

Many whitebark pines in the Rocky Mountains have been devastated by pine beetles. An innovative restoration project involves collecting pine cones from disease-resistant trees to grow seedlings that can be replanted in severely impacted areas. Pheromone patches that repel beetles contribute to the project as well.

## David T. Vernon Collection

200 tribes represented. Gifted by Laurance S. Rockefeller in 1976.

One of the finest Plains Indian art and artifact collections in the world is located at Colter Bay Visitor Center, however, the building does not offer museum-quality storage and exhibit cases. Some pieces will soon be featured in new display cases provided by the Foundation at the Craig Thomas Discovery and Visitor Center. In time, a space will be created to permanently showcase and protect this irreplaceable collection.

## Youth Engagement Initiative

### YOUTH CONSERVATION PROGRAM

100 teens and 42,000 hours of work since 2006. 10 weeks.

Each June-August, 20 teens eager for outdoor adventures make the youth crew a success. Trail work, historic site repairs, and other projects intersect with mentors and environmental education for a one-of-a-kind job and a summer to remember.

### PURA VIDA, LATINO FAMILY DAYS, AND YOUNG STEWARDS & LEADERS

22 students, plus friends/family. 3 weeks spring break/summer.

Camping, canoeing, and scores of other activities are featured in these outreach and leadership programs. Latino students and their families are welcomed into the park to learn about resources and careers and to begin developing a comfort level with nature they have not previously experienced.

### NPS ACADEMY

21 interns. 13 national parks.

Up and coming professionals connect with NPS mentors for a career prep project that aims to introduce young, diverse college students to park jobs across the country.

Grand Teton hosted 8 students and planted career seeds that are growing.

## Jenny Lake Trail Restoration

Planning is underway. Project will celebrate the NPS centennial in 2016.

The Jenny Lake trail system is the oldest in the park and also Grand Teton's most popular area.

A large-scale legacy project is on the drawing board and will greatly improve trails to Hidden Falls and Inspiration Point while also addressing erosion and other challenges.

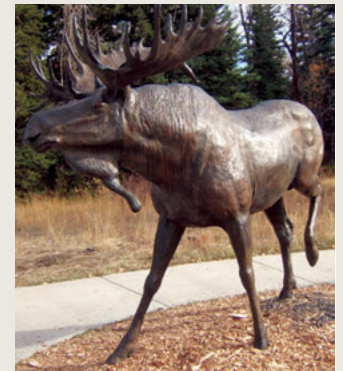
