THE CRAIG THOMAS DISCOVERY AND VISITOR CENTER IS A 22,000-SQUARE-FOOT FACILITY THAT ORIENTS, EDUCATES, AND INSPIRES VISITORS TO MAKE DISCOVERIES OF THEIR OWN IN THE PARK. THE RESULT OF AN INNOVATIVE PUBLIC-PRIVATE COLLABORATION BETWEEN GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK AND THE FOUNDATION, THE CENTER HAS BEEN WELCOMING VISITORS TO GRAND TETON SINCE ITS OPENING IN 2007.

THE FY23 WORK AT THE CRAIG THOMAS DISCOVERY VISITOR CENTER EXPLORED THE CONCEPT OF REHABILITATING THE FOUR VISITOR RESTROOMS LOCATED WITHIN THE BUILDING, WHICH HAVE DEGRADED SINCE THE BUILDING OPENED MORE THAN SIXTEEN YEARS AGO. THE TEAM WORKED ON A REDESIGN OF THE RESTROOMS TO UPDATE THE FACILITIES AND IMPROVE THE VISITOR EXPERIENCE. CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS WERE FINALIZED BUT A CONTRACT WAS NOT AWARDED AND THE PROJECT IS NOT MOVING FORWARD AT THIS TIME.

RANGER SUPPORT:

THE HIGH PEAKS, MOUNTAIN CANYONS, AND GLACIAL LAKES OF GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK DRAW RECREATIONISTS FROM AROUND THE WORLD WHO ARE EAGER TO EXPLORE THIS ICONIC LANDSCAPE. THE JENNY LAKE RANGERS ARE THE PARK'S TEAM OF SEARCH AND RESCUE PROFESSIONALS WHO PROVIDE A WIDE RANGE OF ASSISTANCE TO VISITORS IN NEED. FROM INJURED CLIMBERS ON THE GRAND TETON TO HIKERS WITH SPRAINED ANKLES ONLY A FEW MILES FROM THE TRAILHEAD, THE JENNY LAKE RANGERS ARE ALWAYS READY TO RESPOND. GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK FOUNDATION HAS PROVIDED PRIVATE PHILANTHROPIC SUPPORT FOR THIS TEAM SINCE 2018. THE MAIN FOCUS AREAS TO ADVANCE RANGER EXCELLENCE IN GRAND TETON ARE TO:

STATE LANDS/KELLY PARCEL:

TOTALING 640 ACRES, THE STATE-OWNED KELLY PARCEL IS THE LARGEST TRACT OF UNPROTECTED LAND REMAINING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK. THE ELEVATED SQUARE-MILE PROVIDES SWEEPING VIEWS OF THE TETON RANGE AND INCLUDES CRITICAL HABITAT FOR NUMEROUS SPECIES OF WILDLIFE. THE PARCEL IS ALSO LOCATED WITHIN A KEY MIGRATION CORRIDOR FOR PRONGHORN, ELK, AND MULE DEER. IF THE KELLY PARCEL IS NOT PERMANENTLY CONSERVED AS PART OF GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK, THIS INHOLDING COULD BE DEVELOPED, RISKING THE LOSS OF VITAL HABITAT IN THE GREATER YELLOWSTONE ECOSYSTEM—ONE OF THE LAST REMAINING, NEARLY INTACT TEMPERATE ECOSYSTEMS ON THE PLANET. THE INCLUSION OF THIS 640-ACRE TRACT IN GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK HAS BEEN A SIGNIFICANT CONSERVATION PRIORITY FOR THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR FOR DECADES. IN 2023, THE FOUNDATION SUPPORTED THE PARK IN ITS EFFORTS TO ACQUIRE THIS ESSENTIAL LAND FROM THE STATE OF WYOMING.

HOUSING STUDY:

THE FY23 HOUSING STUDY INITIATED PRELIMINARY DISCUSSIONS FOR DEVELOPING NEW HOUSING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK. THE EFFORT INCLUDED A CONCEPTUAL

THE FOUNDATION HAS FUNDED PRESERVATION OF THE TWO LARGEST STRUCTURES AT THE BAR BC, THE CORSE AND MAIN CABINS, FOR THE LAST SEVERAL YEARS. IN 2023, PROVIDED SUPPORT TO FINISH ESSENTIAL PRESERVATION WORK AT THE MAIN CABIN, ENABLING PARK VISITORS TO SAFELY EXPERIENCE THIS BEAUTIFUL CULTURAL GEM.
