CHARTING A SUSTAINABLE PATH:

VISITOR MANAGEMENT AT GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK

n recent years, park visitors, partners, and neighbors have been more commonly asking Grand Teton National Park leaders, "When are you going to start managing visitation?" Surprisingly to some, the National Park Service has been managing visitation for more than 100 years at Grand Teton, actively guiding and directing people to specific destinations in the park, places to see wildlife, as well as locations of historic significance.

Over the years, the ways in which people explore Grand Teton has continued to change and so have the ways in which the park has worked to improve the visitor experience, all while simultaneously protecting the park's wildlife, scenery, ecological communities, and historic resources. An early example of what today the park calls visitor use management dates back to the 1930s when the Jenny Lake Campground was revamped from dispersed camping into a designated campground as a means of protecting the area's natural scenery and vegetation from the impacts of collective use.

Increasing visitation to the park has not gone unnoticed, especially by Jenn Newton, Grand Teton's in-house social scientist, who leads a small team charged with collecting pertinent data on who, how, when, and where visitors experience the park. Results of her work are helping Grand Teton take a fresh look at how people use the park with an eye toward better understanding and defining a positive visitor experience. The information gleaned from surveys and observations are enabling park managers to develop and implement strategies aimed at better managing visitation today while charting a course for the next twenty plus years.

The approach is proactive and adaptive, and is helping ensure that Grand Teton's most iconic and important resources—scenery, wildlife, historic and pre-historic features, mountains, plants, lakes, and streams—are

protected, all while providing opportunities for outstanding and inspirational visitor experiences. As part of this ongoing effort, Grand Teton utilizes the interagency visitor use management framework and works very closely with its neighboring public land managers as well as local, state, and regional stakeholders to develop and implement holistic approaches to visitor use management.

Grand Teton National Park is collaborating with research partners to identify themes that help paint a fuller picture of what a visitor's experience in the park looks like today. Recent studies have revealed four key insights:

1. Increasing and Changing Visitation:

The long-term trend in recreational travel to Grand Teton and surrounding areas is increasing. Recreation visits to the park have grown twenty-two percent in the past ten years. During this timeframe, hikers using the park's trail system have increased thirty-four percent, pointing to a significant shift in how and where visitors explore Grand Teton. Other observed trends show a mismatch between existing park facilities and staff and the strain of increased visitation.

2. Travel Volume and Patterns:

Think about your own visits to Grand Teton. Where do you go? Visitation research indicates vehicle movement to and through the park is highly dispersed and varied, with no dominant travel pattern. Traffic hot spots are most likely to occur in specific parking areas.

3. Recreational/Experience Quality:

Participation in recreational activities in the frontcountry, backcountry, and wilderness areas of the park is increasing. As this trend continues, there is a higher density of visitor activity along some trails and lakeshore areas, resulting in more frequent encounters between individual visitors, which leads to increased perceptions of crowding in parking lots and on trails.

4. Resource Impacts: When natural resources are negatively impacted, visitors' experiences suffer. On busy days, parking areas and scenic turnouts overflow with vehicles, frequently leading to cars parked on road shoulders and damaging vegetation. Frontcountry areas create impressions in park visitors that can bolster or detract from an inspirational park experience.

In summer 2024, the park asked the public for their feedback on desired conditions of visitor experiences in Grand Teton National Park. Defining these desired conditions helps paint an aspirational picture of what a particular destination or park site should look like, feel like, sound like, and function like in the future. Grand Teton's leaders are keen to include input from current visitors to help inform decisions directed at improving the overall park experience.

Park managers are currently reviewing public comments and will begin to evaluate areas where the current condition does not reflect the desired condition. Park staff will define and design management strategies that could be employed in these areas. Grand Teton will continue to reach out to the public and other stakeholders to glean insight and feedback on emerging concepts and

plans. The park may pilot some new management strategies as a means of understanding how they may best be implemented in the long-term to help meet goals.

Grand Teton National Park's commitment to adaptive visitor use management is essential to addressing challenges, including increased crowding, resource degradation, and shifting visitor behaviors. As the park continues to refine its vision for the future, its actions will play a crucial role in preserving the balance between conservation and recreation, ensuring that visitors continue to enjoy Grand Teton's extraordinary landscapes and wildlife in sustainable ways.








SOCIAL SCIENCE INFORMING THE MORMON ROW INITIATIVE

The first step in the visitor use management framework is to assess the current condition of an area. As part of the Foundation and park's multiyear initiative to renew the Mormon Row Historic District, research technicians (including a Foundation-supported NPS Academy social science intern) conducted a visitor use study at Mormon Row in summer 2024. The purpose of this study is to understand how visitors are using the historic district, and how different types of interpretive signage may influence visitor behaviors. Information on levels and types of use, visitor use patterns, and dwell time will inform how the park will improve the visitor experience through interpretive opportunities.

Deployed 15 radio collars on coyotes and 9 radio collars on red foxes as part of a multiyear canid coexistence study that aims to better understand the impact of wolves on other species



At 2:30 am on August 21, two experienced climbers, both emergency room doctors, left the Lupine Meadows Trailhead to climb the North Face of the Grand Teton. They crossed the Teton Glacier and reached the bottom of the route at 7 am to start their ascent. While leading the third pitch, James Dahle reached for a hand hold and dislodged a small rock that hit him in the head. He fell ten meters as his last piece of protection failed. His partner solo climbed up to James, who was unconscious and bleeding from the face. He managed James' airway and moved him to an upright position. James slowly regained consciousness after about ten minutes but was very disoriented. The partner called 911 at 9:40 am, and the dispatcher told him that the Jenny Lake Rangers would initiate a rescue operation.

The Jenny Lake Rangers are Grand Teton's team of elite search and rescue professionals. They protect resources and visitors in the park's vast backcountry. Their duties include walking trails, educating visitors, assessing route conditions, and issuing

permits for overnight camping. Search and rescue is their primary function, although it only accounts for about twenty-percent of their time. They will drop everything else to respond to someone in need—it is their most critical responsibility.

After receiving the page from the dispatcher, the Jenny Lake Rangers, who were already at the Lupine Meadows Rescue Cache for training, quickly assembled to make a plan. The rangers had not performed a rescue on the North Face of the Grand in decades—it is a technical, near vertical face that presents many challenges for first responders. The team determined that a short-haul rescue would be the best option given the location and serious injuries of the patient.

Short-haul is a helicopter rescue technique that flies rescuers into steep, alpine areas by attaching them to a rope that is anchored to the bottom of the aircraft. When weather conditions cooperate, it provides rangers with the ability to reach people in minutes instead of hours. Although it does not come

without risk—hanging below a helicopter while flying through canyons and near high peaks is dangerous. The Jenny Lake Rangers conduct short-haul trainings regularly throughout the year and push themselves to practice in highly technical areas, knowing that when someone is severely injured, they must be confident in their skills.

At 10:38 am, the helicopter launched from the rescue cache with three rangers to perform a reconnaissance flight. Winds were calm, so the team determined there was an adequate safety margin to complete a short-haul rescue. The helicopter returned to the rescue cache, was rigged for the short-haul, and then took off again at 11:15 am. Rescuers were inserted to the scene at 11:25 am. James was stabilized, packaged, and flown back to the rescue cache. An air ambulance was there waiting to transport him to a higher level of care. He was loaded into the helicopter and transported to Eastern Idaho Regional Medical Center in Idaho Falls, ID at 12:12 pm—two hours and thirty-two minutes after the initial call to 911.


James spent four days in the Intensive Care Unit and is still recovering at home from some of his injuries. Without the incredibly fast response of the Jenny Lake Rangers, the outcome could have been entirely different.

This is just one of hundreds of stories from decades of rescues completed by the Jenny Lake Rangers in Grand Teton National Park. The team has averaged eighty-three rescues per year for the last five years. They train in a variety of disciplines annually—law enforcement, wildland fire, emergency medical services (everyone on the team is an EMT, many have higher certifications), and search and rescue, which includes technical rope rescue, wheeled litters, aviation, and short-haul.

An additional focus in recent years has been placed on mental health. The team works with professionals who train in psychological first aid, the stress continuum, and a formalized check-in process. The main goal is to provide resources for team members after responding to a serious accident or fatality.

A new area that the Foundation is supporting this year is an internship program. The Jenny Lake Rangers have hosted interns for the last several years but have lacked funding to formalize the effort and truly support these young, aspiring professionals.

"I was the Jenny Lake Ranger intern in 2020, and I can say with confidence that it is the reason I am now working in this field," Jenny Lake Ranger Zack Little said. "The opportunity to embed within a team that functions at such a high level is completely unique, and I have yet to encounter another opportunity like it."

This fall, I and others from Grand Teton had the opportunity to join more than 250 land managers, researchers, elected officials, leaders from conservation organizations, members of media, and other engaged stakeholders for the sixteenth Biennial Science Conference on the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. A major theme emerged from these substantive and informed conversations: we must prepare to respond to constant change in the ecosystem, particularly change that is out of our control.

Thanks to the critical and sustained support from Grand Teton National Park Foundation, the park is better prepared for the changes that we see coming, much like the signs of winter we see on the mountain slopes.

Through Foundation-supported projects, we are preparing for change in a variety of ways:

- Adapting to changing visitation through projects like Snake River Gateways
- Gaining a better understanding of the headwaters of the Snake River and how changes to glaciers influence the vegetation and wildlife resources downstream through projects like Tracking Snake River Health and Climate Change Impacts on Water Resources
- Building a youth strategy that will better serve the needs of students, parents, the community, and the next generation of park stewards with the Youth Engagement Framework project

Together, we continue to make important progress on the long-term restoration of sagebrush habitat and the monitoring of wildlife movement, health, and mortality to better understand wildlife resiliency in the face of change. This work not only directly broadens our scientific understanding of Grand Teton, but it also contributes to the collective scientific data for the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem available to the network of scientists seeking to respond to changes around the world. In an era of

constant change, we deeply appreciate the consistency of the Foundation in supporting long-term science on wolves, songbirds, pronghorn, mule deer, and elk that is informing conservation efforts in the park, in the state, and across the nation.

We must tirelessly work to preserve the abundant wildlife, clean water, and inspiring scenery that have drawn people here for thousands of years. Thanks to the tangible and ongoing support from Grand Teton National Park Foundation, we are better equipped to meet the needs of today and respond to the change that is coming tomorrow.


